Pulp Clamp - There are actually several different lift truck accessories that could be used in order to make forklifts way more useful. Snowplow attachments can be mounted onto the front part of a forklift. A scoop bucket can be helpful when the job requires transferring gravel, snow, sand, or soil. A double block handler allows the forklift operator to lift\carry 2 loads and pile them beside each other. Lots of of these accessories are extremely great for light to medium tasks.

One more lift truck attachment is the package lift clamp, which could carry and transfer heavier pallets. In addition, pallet crane forks may be utilized so as to carry and move pallets with an overhead crane. A drum clamp accessory is helpful for transferring really heavy drums from one place to another without having to use a pallet. Forklift mounted hoppers allow material to be transferred and dumped without having to handle it manually. These hoppers when the bumper is released are self dumping.

Obtainable attachments now include accessories that permit a forklift to do the task of a commercial broom or mop. Such particular accessories are often used cleaning parking lots, warehouse floors, and boat docks. Forklift mounted platforms come outfitted with dual entry doors and can be connected to be able to move staff from one locale to another.
